Project objective: to improve the competitiveness of seafarers and logistics specialists in ports by improving education quality.

Project funding: project total grant amount – 900 286,39 EUR (765 243,42EUR – 85 % ERDF and 135 042,97 EUR – 15% National public co-financing). LMA receives 294 289,29EUR, of which 250 145,89 EUR – ERDF and 44 143,40 EUR – Lithuanian State budget funding.

Target groups: LMC and LMA students and personnel.

Main project activities:

1. Development of 1 new LMA programme “Port terminal operation” (5 ECTS, 180 hrs.) for students, short term course programme for port terminal employees and qualification upgrading programmes for working personnel in education institution.
2. Development of teaching/learning materials (materials on laboratory works for Port operation simulator; 3 thematic books);
3. Investments in infrastructure and acquisition of specialized training equipment (Port operation simulator)
4. Personnel qualification enhancement and development activities - exchange of practices and training courses abroad.
